APPLICATIONS

All applications will be processed in the order received. An invoice for the exhibitor expenses will be sent upon selection, with places allocated on a first-come-first-serve basis.

SUBMITTED ARTWORKS

To ensure a fair allocation of space, artists may submit:

One artwork, up to a maximum size of 80 x 80cm, inclusive of framing/support

or

Up to **four** smaller artworks, which combined have a maximum size of 80 x 80cm, including framing and space for hanging between works (strictly applied).

EXHIBITION SCHEDULE

Delivery of works: Sunday 5 June, 10am - 4pm

Installation: Monday 6 June

Exhibition open: Tuesday 7 - Saturday 18 June
11am - 6pm, Tuesday to Saturday

Private View: Wednesday 8 June, 6-9pm

Take-down/Collection: Sunday 19 June, 10am - 4pm

DETAILS

As a not-for-profit platform, Bermondsey Project Space takes no commission on sales, however the gallery does ask partners to contribute towards the overheads of running their project. Please note that BPS is NOT a hire venue, with exhibitions and projects being organised in partnership with the Gallery by invitation only.

THE SMALL PRINT

- ▶ The exhibition will be curated and installed by the professional team at BPS. All decisions made by BPS are final.
- ▶ BPS will organise a pay bar for the Private View evening and Meet the Artists afternoon, serving quality red/white wine, local craft beers and a soft drink option. Guests make a £3 donation to BPS per drink, and drinks tokens are available for artists who wish to give their guests a complimentary drink.
- ▶ BPS takes no commission on sales, however, BPS charges a 10% handling and processing fee to cover the costs of banking and payment processing.
- ▶ Sold works can be collected from the Gallery once the exhibition closes

*FACILITIES FEE

Successful applicants are required to pay the subsidised facilities fee of £95 towards the following:

- ✓ Installation of the works
- ✓ Restoration of gallery walls after the exhibition closes
- ✓ Promotion via BPS's extensive mailing list of art world contacts and clients
- ✓ Promotion via the Gallery's social media channels
- ✓ Promotion via collaboration with GalleriesNow, with details of the show going out to over half-a-million collectors worldwide
- ✓ A digital invitation and social media graphics for artists to use
- ✓ A digital catalogue created and distributed via above channels
- ✓ Insurance whilst on Gallery premises via AXA Museum policy (subject to details provided as requested)
- ✓ **NO COMMISSION ON SALES**

on Saturday 18 June. However, delivery of sold artworks to purchasers is the sole responsibility of the artist. The Gallery can assist with on-site collections, or with any designated third party transporters, but will not be responsible for delivery of any item to any location outside of the gallery environs on the grounds of security and insurance cover.

- ▶ All works should be delivered with professionally attached fittings for hanging which are appropriate to the size and weight of the work, ready to install.
- ▶ All packing material should be removed by the artist upon delivery.
- ▶ Please note there is no storage available for works that cannot be delivered/collected to the agreed schedule noted above. If you are unable to deliver/collect to this schedule, please contact the Gallery to discuss alternative arrangements.
